

Tournament Notes:

The only out of bounds this weekend is inside the tennis court, any public roadway and **inside the soccer fields** on holes 1 and 2. There are NO mandatory flight paths on the course.

This is a PDGA B-Tier sanctioned tournament and ALL PDGA rules will be enforced.

Due to the limited amount of daylight we will be encouraging quick play from all players. *801.03 stipulates a maximum of 30 seconds is allowed to each player to make a throw after the previous player has thrown; and, the player has taken a reasonable time to arrive at the disc and mark the lie; and, the playing area is clear and free of distractions.* Please make your way promptly to your disc and mark your lie as soon as possible. See Section 3.2 of the Competition Manual for more details. Please also invoke rule 801.02-C which states in part that *To facilitate flow of play, a player who is not farthest away may play next if the away player consents.* This is beneficial when putting out on a hole or when a closer player is able to get in position to throw before an away player can get to their disc.

The two meter rule IS in effect. If a disc has come to rest above two meters, as measured from the lowest point of the disc to the playing surface directly below it, the player shall be assessed a one-throw penalty. See 803.08 for details.

Marking the Lie and Holing Out is NOT optional. (See section 803.03 and 803.13 for details)

At the end of the round, each player shall sign his or her scorecard indicating that he or she attests to the accuracy of the score on each hole and the total score. All players are responsible for returning their scorecards within 25 minutes after the completion of the round. If it is determined that the total score was incorrectly recorded...the director shall add two penalty throws to the correct total score.

Players are expected to behave in a **professional** and **sportsmanlike** manner while participating in a **PDGA** sanctioned event. Actions that are in violation of this conduct include but are not limited to: *loud cursing, throwing items in anger, overt rudeness, destruction, abuse or vandalism of property, cheating or willful attempt to circumvent the rules of play, physical attacks or threatening behavior, any activity in violation of Federal, State or local laws or ordinances or park regulations, excessive use of alcohol or the use of illegal substances at the tournament site and underage drinking.*

The use of **alcohol and illegal substances** is forbidden from the two minute warning until the player's scorecard is submitted. Such use shall result in **immediate disqualification** from the event.

Players who commit Professional Misconduct will be reported to the **PDGA** and may also be subject to disciplinary actions by the **PDGA**.
